## **Hebrews 1:5 - end**

<sup>5</sup>For to which of the angels did God ever say, “You are my Son; today I have begotten you”? Or again, “I will be his Father, and he will be my Son”? <sup>6</sup>And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says, “Let all God’s angels worship him”. <sup>7</sup>Of the angels he says, “He makes his angels winds and his servants flames of fire”. <sup>8</sup>But of the

Son he says, “Your throne, O God, is forever and ever and the sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of your kingdom. <sup>9</sup>You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness beyond your companions”. <sup>10</sup>And, “In the beginning, Lord, you founded the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands; <sup>11</sup>they will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like clothing; <sup>12</sup>like a cloak you will roll them up, and like clothing they will be changed. But you are the same, and your years will never end”. <sup>13</sup>And to which of the angels has he ever said, “sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet”? <sup>14</sup>Are not all angels spirits in the divine service, sent to serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation?

## **John 1:43-end**

### **Jesus Calls Philip and Nathanael**

<sup>43</sup>The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him, “Follow me”. <sup>44</sup>Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter. <sup>45</sup>Philip found Nathanael and said to him, “We have found him about whom Moses in the Law and also the Prophets wrote, Jesus son of Joseph from Nazareth”. <sup>46</sup>Nathanael said to him, “Can anything good come out of Nazareth?” Philip said to him, “Come and see”. <sup>47</sup>When Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him, he said of him, “Here is truly an Israelite in whom there is no deceit!” <sup>48</sup>Nathanael asked him, “Where did you get to know me?” Jesus answered, “I saw you under the fig tree before Philip called you”. <sup>49</sup>Nathanael replied, “Rabbi, you are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!” <sup>50</sup>Jesus answered, “Do you believe because I told you that I saw you under the fig tree? You will see greater things than these”. <sup>51</sup>And he said to him, “Very truly, I tell you, you will see heaven opened and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man.”
